Offers flexible access to Pierce and Pierce After Dark, \$100 Duck Bills and 5 Guest Meals. Flex Access is designed for the commuter or Co-Op student who wants the same great food, comfortable ambience, engaging entertainment and After Dark experience as the Ultimate Access but has less scheduling flexibility. Flex Access comes with 240 swipes and allows you to eat breakfast, lunch, dinner, or Pierce After Dark anytime during the semester (only 1 swipe per meal period). It has the added benefit of letting you decide which meals on which days work best with your schedule.
